**OUR SETS:** For our Limited Edition specials such as Bunnies & Ducks, we spend weeks designing, building and assembling new sets every year. Each one is different, gorgeous and realistic. This year we'll have a duck pond complete with greenery, spring color, a fishing dock and lots of fun surprises. Along, of course, with the usual adorable (real) baby bunnies & ducks.

**YOUR EXPERIENCE**: Before the session, we'll help you so you'll know how to plan for a great session.

During the session, we keep things fun and light. We know how to put everyone at ease and how to bring about the expressions and emotion you're looking for. If siblings are involved, we pride ourselves on showing that special connection between them

with realistic posing. Creating an environment that's relaxed and fun puts you at ease, keeps even the smallest participants engaged and it's the surest way to bring about natural reactions (though the baby animals can do that all by themselves sometimes!).

**OUR WORK**: We will offer you a great variety of pictures to select from - lots of natural expressions, everything from closeups to a fuller view of the set. Post production, lots of technical expertise goes into creating every finished piece, from our beautiful wall pieces to our smaller gift portraits and everything in between.

All this care and experience results in family masterpieces that you will be proud to gift to family and friends and to display in your home...for generations to come. Because when you purchase a Pixel Perfect product you are buying more than a photo, you are buying a meticulously created piece of art produced just for you.



### Session - Plan A LITTLE, GAIN A LOT!

The last thing we want is to turn a fun experience into something stressful so here's a few tips and tricks to help you be cool, calm and totally in control!

**PLAN AHEAD** - A few days before, gather together everything you plan to bring. This way you'll know beforehand if you need to get something cleaned, pressed or purchased. Try clothes on beforehand to be sure they fit. This will help to avoid the last minute crazies.

HAIR AWARE - If you must cut your child's hair, it's best to do so a week or two before the event so the cut has a chance to 'breathe.' Looking for a great hair bow? We have lots to choose from so don't fret if you don't have just the right one handy.

**REWARDS** - I totally believe in bribery when used with care. If you go this route, agree between yourselves on a reward in advance and let us know so I can be on the same page. And always save it for after the session.

**HAPPY HOUR** - If at all possible plan your session time to correspond with your smallest child's 'best time.' The older kids can usually handle different timeframes a little better but smaller folks often still need naps. So plan accordingly if at all possible.

CHILL PILL - When you arrive, take a deep calming breath and trust us. We've been doing this a long time and we know what we're doing. Our goal is to not only give you great images but a great experience. So don't worry about what to do during the session - we'll handle it. And don't worry if your kids aren't behaving exactly as you'd wish. Let us work our magic and if we need your help we won't be shy about asking.







Imagine your child enjoying the experience of a peaceful day down by the pond. They'll hug baby bunny, smell a flower, read a book or watch the water ripple



while the baby ducks swim at their feet and the baby bunnies rest at their side.

The focal point of our set this year is the duck pond (yeah, real water, but just not very deep!). The set is new - different background, an old tree trunk for sitting and lots more! Adding to the dimension of the set is plush greenery and pond fronds and spots of Spring flowers. We have baskets for the bunnies and the ducks, or perhaps to hold a flower or two and numerous other beautiful and timeless props. We're very excited to bring this set to life and create a little magic for you and your child.

Let the images on this page guide you. Making the right color and style choices is one of the most important things you can do to help us create timeless works of art that you'll treasure forever.

Dress this set up with your Easter finest or dress it down with denim and khaki. Casual vintage or classic

clothing will look great. Colors that work best: pale blue, pale green, pale yellow, tan, cream, peach, neutrals. Keep the colors muted. Use solids if at all possilble. If using a pattern, keep it subtle and small.



Keep clothing classic and the colors subtle and you will have lots of options in where to place a portrait in your homd. If you can match the colors in a portrait to a specific room's decor it can really add a lot to your room and your home.

FOR BOYS: Long pants on boys (pants or overalls) and denims, khakis or linen on the bottom. Soft materials for the shirts and keep them neutral or pastel and solid colors. A barefoot little boy in denim (pants or overalls) and no shirt at all is also a great look.

**FOR GIRLS:** soft, flowy dresses with longer dresses or skirts are best. Make sure skirts have lots of room in a sitting position (nothing tight around the bottom). Denim pants or overalls and soft, flowy tops are a great, more casual alternative. Softer materials that move well are the best choice.


**SIBLINGS:** Keep in mind that you don't need to match everyone in the same top and bottom. Pick a color palette (it can be one of ours or select your own) based on our suggestions, your home decor and your preferences. Feel free to mix and match clothing layers and textures.

**DON'TS**: Avoid white or bright and bold/loud colors, no pencil or short skirts or short dresses on girls. No shorts on boys. Avoid stripes, bold patterns and plaids. Don't worry about shoes, we generally won't include them (bare feet are always cuter down by the pond!).















The addition of wall portraits instantly adds a focal point to a any room and can really pull together your decor. Wall pieces also make great conversation pieces and share a little bit about what's important to you. Here are a few decorating tips that we've gleaned from interior decorators that will give you the inside scoop on how to make your home come alive.



Consider the style and function of the room. A formal living room might require a more traditional portrait, a nursery can get away with something more playful.



As a general rule, artwork should occupy roughly 60-70% of the wall space above a furniture piece.



Combining multiple portraits creates a big impact and will tell your chid's story better than a single portrait could. Ask about our multiple wall portrait discounts!



Repeating the same colors in the room and your portrait can increase the impact within the room. That's why it's important to think about where you may want to hang a portrait as you are making clothing choices for your session.



### Take the guesswork out of planning for a wall piece! It's as easy as 1, 2, 3!



Tape a letter-sized (8.5x11) piece of paper on the wall where you'd like your portrait.



Using your handiest camera or a smartphone take a HORIZONTAL picture of the wall (with the paper on it). Shoot straight on, not at an angle. Include as much of the furniture as possible.

# Price Points

### WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT TO SPEND

We offer A La Carte pricing as well as a number of packages, which offer discounts of 20% to 50% built in. Save more when you bundle!

The following figures offer samples of our price points and ballpark estimates of what our clients usually spend at our Bunnies & Ducks sessions.

- If you are looking for a couple of gift portraits (8x10 or smaller), expect to spend just under \$200.
- Wall portraits are hand finished and framed and ready to hang on your wall; they come in 2 finishes and start at \$339.
- Session books are meticulously created and beautiful to hold; they start with 20 of your favorite images at \$599.
- People who join us for the Bunnies & Ducks sessions generally spend \$300 \$500 in portrait products. In the \$300 price range a typical package includes 5 gift portaits (8x10 or smaller) and a single pose. In the \$500 price range our most popular package includes a small wall piece, 2 gift portraits and 2 high res digital files.
- Individual and multiple digital files are included in many of our packages and are available as add-ons to any package, as are our custom Easter cards.







**CAMERAS IN THE STUDIO:** Sometimes people ask, sometimes purely out of habit someone will whip out a cell phone and start taking pictures in my studio. It's tempting, I know, you're used to doing it everywhere you go (me too!). But the only cameras allowed in my camera room are my own. Thanks for understanding!!

**PAYMENTS:** We accept cash, personal checks, Visa, Discover and Mastercard. For orders over \$600 we offer interest-free time payments.


**MINIMUM PURCHASE:** There is a minimum purchase of \$99.

MY CHILD IS SHY: My son was quite possibly the most shy small child I ever met, so I know something about kids who need time to warm up. If we have not met before I'll always spend a few minutes with you before the session getting up to speed. I'm good with kids of all ages and can usually make anyone comfortable pretty quickly (and the baby animals can be a real ice-breaker). If you suspect your child may have a difficult time with the animals come in a little early so they have time to get acquainted.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE TIME TO PLACE MY ORDER IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE SESSION? Just let us know and we'll fit you in our schedule on a different date at a mutually agreeable time.

DO THE BUNNIES AND DUCKS SCRATCH? Ducks don't scratch at all but bunnies can scratch so we are super careful with them and with your children. We usually will put the bunnies in a basket or just beside the child to start. We don't ask a child to hold the bunnies unless they and we are absolutely comfortable. The bunnies we use are also very friendly and used to petting - we borrow them from a local petting zoo and they only bring along animals that are super friendly. We also have a bunny and a duck wrangler in the camera room at all times, just focusing on the safety of both the animals and your child. We will ask you to sign a release just before the session but we have never had an issue and we have been offering bunny and duck sessions for years.
